The Inside Story

- A 1-year warranty inspection was conducted on the new administration building on November 20, 2006.
- A new stand-alone air conditioning unit will need to be purchased for the AADAC premises.
- The Special Education Committee is currently updating their procedures for the division.
- A facility binder will be created that will assist school administrators with general maintenance issues such as custodial services, alarm systems, etc.
- A Blessed Sacrament School Council meeting will be held on Tuesday, December 5, 2006 at Central Office. The board members and Central Office staff are welcome to attend.
- The Little Steps junior kindergarten program being held at Blessed Sacrament School has 60 children registered this year, ages 3 and 4 years.
- The overall divisional operating deficit for the 2005/2006 school year is \$310,467.
- Total instructional spending in schools increased by 11% compared to 2004/2005.

- The financial statements for the year ended August 31, 2006 were approved at the November board meeting.
- The board approved the program, "I See, I Learn". The program will provide eye exams to students within ECACS.
- When students in the division participate in provincial level activities, the board will provide financial support as follows: Maximum of \$500 to cover travel and accommodations for individual sports and a maximum of \$1000 (or \$100 per student) for team sports.
